Dave Coble said that the Southwest Bicycle store is offering a 20% discount on August 6, 2013. The store is located at 8155 West Bell Road #116, Peoria, AZ 85382. Gail Hildebrant mentioned that Reed Kempton, the bicycle coordinator for Scottsdale is retiring towards the end of August. ## **VII. Bicycle Friendly Community-Feedback Report Spring 2013:**

Purab Adabala presented a brief overview of the feedback report for Glendale. Mr. Adabala mentioned that Glendale got an Honorable mention form the League of American Bicyclists. Mr. Adabala added that there are plenty of recommendations included in the report, some of which can be short term targets and others long terms goals. John Horvath mentioned that the three-foot safe distance rule is a statewide law. Mr. Horvath suggested that in the next application for Bicycle Friendly Community information that was not included should be added to make Glendale a Bicycle Friendly Community. Dave Coble suggested that CTOC representation is missing from the Committee. Mr. Coble mentioned that Glendale needs to push to get as many of the recommendations implemented as possible in light of the report. Mr. Coble also asked that the City of Glendale Planning Director be asked to be present at the next Citizen Bicycle Advisory Committee meeting to see what could be done from a Planning process to incorporate bicycle related amenities into developments. As an example Mr. Coble mentioned that the new Outlet Mall in west Glendale does not provide bicycle parking. Mr. Coble also asked that members of the Committee talk to any elected official to see if they would provide some support for incorporating some ordinances suggested in the report. Gail Hildebrant asked that an implementation plan and schedule be identified that can then be tracked by the Committee. Erik Flodin mentioned that Traffic Skills 101 training is available if Glendale were to provide the space. Ms. Hildebrant suggested that the Glendale Adult Center could be a good location for this training/workshop. Mr. Adabala asked if the group would be interested in asking the Phoenix/Mesa Bicycle Share Program representative to present information on the Program at the next Citizen Bicycle Advisory Committee meeting. All committee members showed interest in the Program.
