MINUTES

I. CALL TO ORDER

Vice Chair Gail Hildebrant called the meeting to order at 6:31 PM.

II. APPROVAL OF MINUTES

Erik Flodin moved to approve the June 2, 2014 Citizen Bicycle Advisory Committee (CBAC) meeting minutes and John Horvath seconded the motion. The minutes from June 2, 2014 meetings were unanimously (6-0) approved.

VI. REPORTS FROM OTHER COMMITTEES AND ORGANIZATIONS

CBAC member Grose reported about Left Turn Signals and Light Rail presentations at the October 2, 2014 Citizen Transportation Oversight Commission (CTOC) meeting.

CBAC member Hildebrant reported that the Coalition of Arizona Bicyclists have a scheduled meeting on October 18, 2014 at 12:00 PM.

CBAC member Flodin wanted to Know when the Transportation Plan will be updated since the current Plan is about five years old.

VII. BIKE LANES AND BIKE ROUTES

Purab Adabala made a presentation on bike lanes and bike routes in Glendale. Mr. Adabala presented some of the street locations in and around Glendale that have designated Bike Lanes and Bike Routes. He

identified ways to differentiate between Bike Lanes and Bike Routes. He clarified the minimum standards for a designated Bike Lane including width, striping, and signage that are required.

VIII. FUTURE AGENDA ITEMS

The following future agenda items proposed:

- Glendale Police Department Bike Training Presentation – Vice Chair Hildebrant mentioned that in working with Police Department the presentation that currently last about 29 minutes might need to be pared down to either 15 minutes or have two presentations of 15 minutes each.
- List of Glendale Bicycle & Pedestrian projects – CBAC member Flodin was interested to know about CBAC accomplishments. Mr. Adabala mentioned projects that are completed and planned for the future can be presented to the CBAC as an agenda item.
- Potential for a smart devise application for bicyclists – CBAC member Flatau wanted to know if Glendale was working on a software application for bicyclists to use. Mr. Adabala mentioned that Glendale Water Services had looked into a software application for their use before and that he would bring back information on this for the CBAC.
- Bicycle & Pedestrian information package that could be put together for Super Bowl 2015 – CBAC member Flatau wanted to know if Glendale plans on putting together an information packet for use during the 2015 Super Bowl to promote the bicycle mode of transportation.
