

**Make sure your children are immunized as they head back to school.** To recognize the importance of immunizations and make sure children are protected with all the vaccines they need, the Glendale Fire Department is joining with partners nationwide in recognizing August as National Immunization Awareness Month.



In the last two years, the Glendale Fire Department's Immunization program provided 1,224 immunizations to 350 children at no cost to the families but due to changes in healthcare reform, the administrative funding for the program, which was provided by the Maricopa County Childhood Immunization Partnership, has been discontinued. The city is now seeking community assistance to obtain new funding.
