Upcoming City Of Glendale Holiday Notices. City of Glendale offices will be closed for the upcoming holidays: half day on Tuesday, Dec. 24 and all day Wednesday, Dec. 25 for the Christmas holiday, as well as Wednesday, Jan. 1 in observance of the New Year's holiday.

This year, an additional closure will mean that most administrative functions within the city will be closed the entire week of Dec. 23-27.

All households' scheduled garbage and recycling will be shifted one day due to the holidays, from Mondays to Tuesdays, and so on. The Glendale Municipal Landfill will close early on Christmas Eve Dec. 24 at noon, and will be closed on Dec. 25 and Jan. 1. Valley Metro will be running a holiday schedule (Sunday service hours) on Tuesday, Dec. 24, Wednesday, Dec. 25 and Tuesday, Jan. 1. Gus 1 will be running a Sunday schedule (8 a.m. to 6 p.m.) on both Tuesday and Wednesday (Dec. 24-25). Gus 2 and 3 will be running until noon on Dec. 24 but will not run on Dec. 25. Gus 1 only will be running a Sunday schedule (8 a.m. to 6 p.m.) on New Year's Day.

For Dial-a-Ride service on Dec. 24 or 25, reservations should be made by noon on Tuesday, Dec. 24. The dispatch office will reopen for reservations on Dec. 26. ADA service will be available both days; callers will be able to leave a message with their request and will be contacted by staff to confirm. For Dial-a-Ride service on Jan. 1, reservations should be made by noon on Tuesday, Dec. 31. Reservations can be made by calling Glendale's Transit Division at 623-930-3500.

Glendale's Foothills Recreation and Aquatics Center will be open on Christmas Eve from 7 a.m. to noon, closed on Dec. 25 and open on Dec. 26, from 8 a.m. to 2 p.m. The center will also be open on New Year's Eve, Dec. 31, from 5:30 a.m. to 5 p.m. and Jan. 1 from 9 a.m. to 4 p.m. For more information on the Foothills Recreation and Aquatics Center, call 623-930-4600. The Glendale Adult Center and Glendale's three public libraries will be closed the entire week of Dec. 23-27 and Jan. 1.

Google Puts Glendale Civic Center on the Map. The layout of the Glendale Civic Center is now at your fingertips right inside your smart phone. The award-winning city facility has a spot on indoor Google Maps, a mapping system that allows people to browse through a building's floor plan from any smart phone.

Civic Center guests can navigate through the building, just as they would through city streets, to see the context of where rooms are located and have the ability to zoom into detailed floor plans that appear on the map. As guests arrive they can literally use their smart phone to find which room their event is located in, restrooms and entrances and exits.

The link can be accessed via <http://goo.gl/maps/TWenm> or through a search on the Google map app or google.com on your smart phone. Indoor maps are becoming very popular and are available more and more in select facilities around the world such as airports, museums, shopping malls, sports venues and convention centers.

Having the Civic Center on Google's indoor mapping system was at no cost to the city. The indoor map is just the latest effort the facility is making in terms of aiding accessibility. Recently, the Glendale Civic Center installed an FM System, which provides the technology for guests with hearing loss free of charge. This system is comprised of a wire with the building that transmits an audio signal directly to a hearing aid, eliminating background noise thus creating clear communication with speakers, musicians and presentations.

The Glendale Civic Center offers 40,000 square feet of indoor and outdoor meeting space for corporate events, trade shows, weddings and private parties. Arizona Catering, a local business for more than 25 years, is the venue's official caterer.
