At approximately 8:00 a.m. this morning there was a shooting at Independence High School here in Glendale. Glendale police officers were on the scene within two minutes, the school was immediately placed on "lock-down" and the uninvolved students and faculty were kept safe from harm. Glendale Fire Department paramedics attended to the two young people who were shot, but unfortunately they did not survive their injuries. We can all be proud of the way our well-trained men and women responded when called upon to deal with this unimaginable tragedy. While I am thankful this was not a "school shooting" in the sense of so many we have come to know over recent years, it is events like this which keep us mindful of just how precious life is. Please keep these two young souls, their families, and our first responders in your thoughts over the next few days. Thank you.


