**Public Meetings Held For West Phoenix/Central Glendale Transit Light Rail Corridor Study.** Valley Metro will hold one more public meeting on the West Phoenix/Central Glendale Light Rail Transit Corridor Study. The study will determine what type of transit (light rail or bus rapid transit) is best for the corridor and where to locate the route. Several routes are under consideration to connect downtown Glendale to the existing light rail system within a transit service area of 19th Ave. on the east, 67th Ave. on the west, Northern Ave. on the north and Camelback Rd. on the south.

Valley Metro will present the latest information on the study and provide an opportunity for questions and comments.

**Truth In Taxation Hearing – Notice Of Tax Increase.** In compliance with Arizona Revised Statutes, the City of Glendale is notifying its property taxpayers of the City of Glendale's intention to raise its primary property taxes 96 cents for every \$100,000 over last year's level. All interested citizens are invited to attend the public hearing on the tax increase that is scheduled to be held on **Tuesday, June 9, 2015 at 6 p.m.** at the Glendale City Council Chambers located at 5850 W. Glendale Ave.

**Glendale To Host Public Meetings On Proposed Anti-Discrimination Ordinance.** The City of Glendale will hold a series of public meetings to allow residents and businesses an opportunity to share their thoughts on whether the city should adopt an anti-discrimination ordinance. The Glendale City Council has expressed specific interest in hearing feedback from Glendale residents and business owners.
