A RESOLUTION OF THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF GLENDALE, MARICOPA COUNTY, ARIZONA, AUTHORIZING AND DIRECTING THE ENTERING INTO OF AN INTERGOVERNMENTAL AGREEMENT (REIMBURSEMENT AGREEMENT) WITH THE MARICOPA COUNTY SHERIFF'S OFFICE BY ASSIGNING A GLENDALE POLICE OFFICER TO THE HIGH INTENSITY DRUG TRAFFICKING AREA (HIDTA) TASK FORCE; AND INCREASING THE GLENDALE POLICE DEPARTMENT'S AUTHORIZED SWORN STRENGTH BY ONE FULL-TIME EMPLOYEE.


BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF GLENDALE as follows:

SECTION 1. That it is deemed in the best interest of the City of Glendale and the citizens thereof that a Reimbursement Agreement with the Maricopa County Sheriff's Office whereby a Glendale Police Officer is assigned to the High Intensity Drug Trafficking Area (HIDTA) Task Force be entered into, which agreement is now on file in the office of the City Clerk of the City of Glendale.


SECTION 2. That the Mayor or City Manager and the City Clerk be authorized and directed to execute and deliver all necessary documents on behalf of the City of Glendale.

SECTION 3. That the authorized sworn strength of the Glendale Police Department is hereby increased by one full-time employee.


