

RESOLUTION NO. 3444 NEW SERIES

A RESOLUTION OF THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF GLENDALE, MARICOPA COUNTY, ARIZONA, AUTHORIZING AND DIRECTING THE ENTERING INTO OF AN INTERGOVERNMENTAL AGREEMENT WITH THE DEER VALLEY UNIFIED SCHOOL DISTRICT FOR THE ASSIGNMENT OF ONE POLICE OFFICER FOR DEER VALLEY HIGH SCHOOL TO AID IN REDUCING CRIME ON THE SCHOOL CAMPUS THROUGH EDUCATION, POSITIVE INTERACTION AND ENFORCEMENT.

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF GLENDALE as follows:

SECTION 1. That it is deemed in the best interest of the City of Glendale and the citizens thereof that an intergovernmental agreement with the Deer Valley Unified School District for the assignment of one police officer for Deer Valley High School to aid in reducing crime on the school campus through education, positive interaction and enforcement be entered into, which agreement is on file in the office of the City Clerk of the City of Glendale.

SECTION 2. That the Mayor or City Manager and the City Clerk are hereby directed and authorized to execute and deliver all documents necessary on behalf of the City of Glendale.




