

RESOLUTION NO. 3538 NEW SERIES

A RESOLUTION OF THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF GLENDALE, MARICOPA COUNTY, ARIZONA, APPROVING THE APPLICATION FOR LOCAL, REGIONAL AND STATE PARKS FUNDS FOR PEDESTRIAN/BICYCLE PARK COMPLEX ACQUISITION AND DEVELOPMENT.

WHEREAS, the Legislature under A.R.S. Sec. 41-503 has authorized the establishment of the Local, Regional and State Parks program, providing funds to the State of Arizona and other eligible applicants for acquiring lands and developing facilities for public outdoor recreation purposes; and

WHEREAS, the Arizona State Parks Board (BOARD) is responsible for the administration of the program within the State, setting up necessary rules and procedures governing application by State and local agencies under the program; and

WHEREAS, said adopted procedures established by the BOARD require the applicant to certify by resolution the approval of applications, signature authorization, the availability of local matching funds, and authorization to sign a Participant Agreement with the BOARD prior to submission of said applications to the BOARD.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF GLENDALE as follows:

SECTION 1. That the City of Glendale approves the filing of an application for FY 2002 Local, Regional and State Parks grant assistance.

SECTION 2. That the City of Glendale certifies that the application is consistent and compatible with all adopted plans and programs of the City of Glendale for outdoor recreation improvements.


SECTION 3. That the City of Glendale agrees to comply with all appropriate procedures, guidelines, and requirements established by the BOARD as a part of the application process.

SECTION 4. That the City of Glendale certifies that it will comply with all appropriate state and federal regulations, policies, guidelines, and requirements as they relate to the application.


SECTION 5. That the City of Glendale certifies that it has matching funds in the amount of \$534,347 from the City of Glendale's Flood Control Bonds, Park Development Impact Fees, the City of Glendale Grants Fund and \$10,000 in kind contribution from the American Bicycle Association.


SECTION 6. That the City of Glendale appoints the City Manager or his designees (Assistant City Manager, Deputy City Manager, Parks and Recreation Director and City Engineer) as agents of the City of Glendale to conduct all negotiations, execute and submit all documents including but not limited to applications, agreements, amendments, billing statements, and so on which may be necessary for the completion of the aforementioned project.
