

RESOLUTION NO. 3665 NEW SERIES

A RESOLUTION OF THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF  
GLENDALE, MARICOPA COUNTY, ARIZONA, APPROVING  
THE ARIZONA STATE PARKS FY 2003 TRAILS HERITAGE  
FUND APPLICATION FOR GRAND CANAL TRAIL  
RENOVATIONS AND IMPROVEMENTS.

WHEREAS, the Legislature under A.R.S. Sec. 41-503 has authorized the establishment of the Trails Heritage Fund program, providing funds to the State of Arizona, its political subdivisions and Indian Tribes for acquiring lands and developing non-motorized trails and facilities for public use; and

WHEREAS, Arizona State Parks Board (BOARD) is responsible for the administration of the program within the State, setting up necessary rules and procedures governing application by local agencies under the program; and

WHEREAS, said adopted procedures established by the BOARD require the applicant to certify by resolution the approval of applications, signature authorization, the availability of local matching funds (if applicable), and authorization to sign a Participant Agreement with the BOARD prior to submission of said applications to the BOARD.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF GLENDALE as follows:

SECTION 1. That the City of Glendale approves the filing of an application for Trails Heritage Fund assistance.

SECTION 2. That the City of Glendale certifies that the application is consistent and compatible with all adopted plans and programs of the City of Glendale for non-motorized trails and facilities development; and the City of Glendale will acquire the land on which the project will be located.

SECTION 3. That the City of Glendale agrees to comply with all appropriate procedures, guidelines, and requirements established by the BOARD as a part of the application process.

SECTION 4. That the City of Glendale certifies that the City of Glendale will comply with all appropriate state and federal regulations, policies, guidelines, and requirements as they relate to the application.

SECTION 5. That the City of Glendale certifies that the City of Glendale has matching funds in the amount of \$84,452 to complete the project as described in the application. Matching cash and design and engineering costs will come from the half-cent sales tax funds allocated to this project in Transportation Fund 25-9465. Tiffany Construction Company, Inc. is donating 0.489 acres valued at \$45,000 pending a formal appraisal for development of a trailhead facility.

The Glendale Arizona Historical Society is donating \$200 of in-kind services to research the history of the Grand Canal for interpretive signage. The Community Partnerships office will provide \$400 of in-kind services to revegetate the trailhead area bringing the entire match amount to \$130,052.

SECTION 6. That the City of Glendale appoints the City Manager (Ed Beasley), Assistant City Manager (Pam Kavanaugh) or Director of Transportation (James A. Book), jointly or individually, as agent(s) of the City of Glendale to conduct all negotiations, execute and submit all documents including, but not limited to, applications, agreements, amendments, billing statements, and so on which may be necessary for the completion of the aforementioned project.


