

RESOLUTION NO. 4051 NEW SERIES

A RESOLUTION OF THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF GLENDALE, MARICOPA COUNTY, ARIZONA, AMENDING THE UTILITIES MISCELLANEOUS CUSTOMER SERVICE FEES PURSUANT TO GLENDALE CITY CODE SEC. 33-83.

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF GLENDALE as follows:

SECTION 1. That pursuant to Glendale City Code Sec. 33-83, the utilities miscellaneous customer service fees are hereby amended as set forth in Exhibit A attached hereto.

SECTION 2. That if any provision or particular fee contained in the attached Exhibit A is for any reason held to be invalid or unconstitutional by any court of competent jurisdiction, such determination shall not affect the validity of the remaining provisions or fees contained in this Resolution.



Annual maintenance fee to help defray the costs of monitoring, inspections, and enforcement actions of non-significant industrial users. <p style="text-align: right;">\$160 year</p>	~
<u>Grease Bearing Waste Discharger Fee:</u>	
Annual maintenance fee for compliance inspections of restaurants and others that are required to maintain grease interceptors to prevent entry of oil and grease into the sewer system and to minimize odor complaints. <p style="text-align: right;">\$160 year</p>	~
<u>Temporary Permit or Manhole Entry Permit:</u>	
Maintenance fee to defray costs of permitting and inspections. <p style="text-align: right;">\$80 issuance</p>	~
<u>Water Main Re-Test Fee:</u>	
Fee intended to provide incentive to contractors to properly flush and prepare water lines constructed to serve new development.
