

RESOLUTION NO. 4343 NEW SERIES

A RESOLUTION OF THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF GLENDALE, MARICOPA COUNTY, ARIZONA, APPROVING AND AUTHORIZING THE SUBMISSION TO THE U.S. DEPARTMENT OF HOUSING AND URBAN DEVELOPMENT OF AN EMERGENCY SHELTER GRANTS (ESG) AMENDMENT TO THE ANNUAL ACTION PLAN FOR FISCAL YEAR 2009-10 TO REALLOCATE \$53,320 IN ESG SAVINGS AND RETURNED FUNDS TO SHELTER OPERATIONS.

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF GLENDALE as follows:

SECTION 1. That it is deemed in the best interest of the City of Glendale and the citizens thereof that the ESG Amendment to the Annual Action Plan for Fiscal Year 2009-10 be entered into, which amendment is now on file in the office of the City Clerk of the City of Glendale.


SECTION 2. That the City Manager or his designee is hereby authorized and directed to submit said Amendment to the U.S. Department of Housing and Urban Development (HUD), and execute any and all necessary documents on behalf of the City of Glendale.

SECTION 3. That the City Manager or his designee is hereby authorized and directed to execute all agreements and documents effectuating the reallocation of \$53,320 to provide A New Leaf-Faith House Emergency Shelter with \$26,660 for emergency domestic violence shelter operational expenses, and to also provide Central Arizona Shelter Services (CASS)-Adult Emergency Shelter with \$26,660 for 24/7 emergency shelter general operating expenses. These funds will assist the City of Glendale in addressing the effects of homelessness, and is hereby approved by Council as long as the action is consistent with the approved Amendment to the Annual Action Plan for Fiscal Year 2009-10.


