

RESOLUTION NO. 4390 NEW SERIES

A RESOLUTION OF THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF
GLENDALE, MARICOPA COUNTY, ARIZONA,
ADOPTING AN IDENTITY THEFT PREVENTION
PROGRAM FOR THE CITY OF GLENDALE UTILITIES
AND FINANCE DEPARTMENTS.

WHEREAS, the Red Flag Rule ("Rule") was developed pursuant to the Fair and Accurate Credit Transactions (FACT) Act of 2003. The Rule was developed in response to the growing threat of identity theft;

WHEREAS, under the Rule, financial institutions and creditors with covered accounts must have identity theft prevention programs to identify, detect and respond to patterns, practices, or specific activities that could indicate identity theft; and

WHEREAS, to comply with the regulations, financial institutions and creditors must develop a written program that identifies and detects the relevant warning signs of potential identify theft or "Red Flags."

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF GLENDALE as follows:

SECTION 1. That the Identity Theft Prevention Program ("Program") for the City of Glendale Utilities and Finance Departments is hereby adopted as an official program of the City of Glendale. A copy of said Program is on file with the Clerk of the City of Glendale.


SECTION 2. That the City Manager is hereby directed to appoint a Program Administrator who may amend and update the Program as needed. Amendments to the Program shall be filed with the Clerk of the City of Glendale.

SECTION 3. That the Program shall become effective June 1, 2010.


