

RESOLUTION NO. 4414 NEW SERIES

A RESOLUTION OF THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF GLENDALE, MARICOPA COUNTY, ARIZONA, AUTHORIZING THE ENTERING INTO OF AN INTERGOVERNMENTAL AGREEMENT WITH THE UNITED STATES DEPARTMENT OF JUSTICE, DRUG ENFORCEMENT ADMINISTRATION (DEA) FOR ASSIGNMENT OF TWO GLENDALE POLICE DETECTIVES TO THE PHOENIX DEA TASK FORCE.

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF GLENDALE as follows:

SECTION 1. That it is deemed in the best interest of the City of Glendale and the citizens thereof that an Intergovernmental Agreement (Task Force Agreement) with the United States Department of Justice, Drug Enforcement Administration (DEA) for the assignment of two Glendale police detectives to the Phoenix DEA Task Force be entered into, which agreement is now on file in the office of the City Clerk of the City of Glendale.

SECTION 2. That the City Council hereby authorizes and directs the Glendale Police Chief, Steven Conrad, to execute and deliver any and all necessary documents on behalf of the Glendale Police Department to effectuate these assignments.
