

RESOLUTION NO. 4706 NEW SERIES

A RESOLUTION OF THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF GLENDALE, MARICOPA COUNTY, ARIZONA, AUTHORIZING THE SUBMISSION OF A GRANT APPLICATION ALONG WITH MATCHING FUNDS TO THE ARIZONA GAME AND FISH HERITAGE FUND PROGRAM FOR A GLENDALE HABITAT GARDEN EDUCATION PROGRAM IN THE CITY OF GLENDALE; AND AUTHORIZING THE ACCEPTANCE OF SAID GRANT IF AWARDED.

WHEREAS, the City of Glendale is requesting grant funding from the Arizona Game and Fish Department for the following project in the City of Glendale:

Project Number: U13011. Glendale Habitat Garden Education Program for the purpose of educating and encouraging homeowners to create sustainable landscapes that attract native wildlife species. The grant request is for \$17,800 with matching funds in the amount of \$17,931.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF GLENDALE as follows:


SECTION 1. That it is deemed in the best interest of the City of Glendale and the citizens that the documents accepting grant funding from the Arizona Game and Fish Department, Project Number U13011 for the Glendale Habitat Garden Education Program at the Glendale Main Library be entered into for the approximate amount of \$17,800.

SECTION 2. That the City of Glendale has matching funds in the amount of \$17,931 if the grant is awarded by the Arizona Game and Fish Department.

SECTION 3. That the City Manager or his designee is appointed as agent of the City of Glendale to conduct all negotiations, execute and submit all documents including but not limited to applications, agreements, amendments, billing statements, and so on which may be necessary for the completion of the aforementioned project.

SECTION 4. That if the application is approved and awarded, the grant is then hereby accepted on behalf of the City of Glendale.
