A RESOLUTION OF THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF GLENDALE, MARICOPA COUNTY, ARIZONA, SUPPORTING THE AMERICAN LEGION DEPARTMENT OF ARIZONA'S RESOLUTION SUPPORTING EFFORTS TO IMPROVE WORKFLOW AT THE PHOENIX VETERANS AFFAIRS HOSPITAL AND BENEFITS FACILITIES AND ALSO CALLING ON CONGRESS TO ENACT LEGISLATION FOR THE AUTOMATIC ENROLLMENT OF FORMER SERVICE MEMBERS IN THE VETERANS AFFAIRS PATIENT ENROLLMENT SYSTEM.

WHEREAS, the American Legion Department of Arizona adopted a resolution forming an ad-hoc committee comprised of veteran service organization experts and independent document management and software experts to study and improve the technology infrastructure and processes utilized to care for veterans at the Phoenix Veterans Affairs hospital and benefits facilities; and


WHEREAS, the American Legion Department of Arizona's resolution also calls on Congress to enact legislation integrating new and existing systems to automatically add service members to the Veteran Affairs patient/benefits enrollment system at the service members' point of separation; and

WHEREAS, the Mayor and the City Council agree that supporting veterans is important to the well-being of our nation and community; and


NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF GLENDALE as follows:




