**SUNBURST FARMS LANDSCAPING PROJECT AWARDED
THROUGH NEIGHBORHOOD IMPROVEMENT GRANTS**

GLENDALE, Ariz. – Soon, neighbors living in the Sunburst Farms Neighborhood Association will have improved median landscaping near their homes, which will be paid for by grants totaling \$90,965 from the city of Glendale’s Neighborhood Partnership Office.

The Sunburst Farms Neighborhood Association is a registered neighborhood of 135 homes, located between 51st and 55th avenues, Paradise Lane to the north and Greenway Road to the south. Most of the properties were built in the 1970’s.

The Citizen’s Advisory Commission on Neighborhoods awarded the funds to the neighbors.

“The project is another great partnership between the city of Glendale and the residents that will result in a visual improvement to the neighborhood’s entry way,” said Mike Nave, chair of the Citizen’s Advisory Commission on Neighborhoods.

“These residents have invested two-years into receiving this grant, which will fund both the formal design work and the construction of new landscape along the north side of Greenway Road between 51st and 55th avenues.”

The Neighborhood Partnership Office administers a grant program that funds revitalization projects twice a year to assist neighborhoods more than 15 years old. Citizen participation and involvement are key components of the program.
