**VII. MAG US-60/Grand Avenue COMPASS (30 minutes)**

The Maricopa County of Governments (MAG) has recently completed the corridor optimization, access management plan, and system study (COMPASS) for the US-60 Grand Avenue corridor. Approximately five miles of this study corridor traverses the City of Glendale. Bob Hazlett, MAG Project Manager, will discuss the recommendations that emerged from the US-60/Grand Avenue COMPASS. In addition, Mr. Hazlett will also discuss MAG’s 99<sup>th</sup> Avenue COMPASS that was completed earlier this year, and briefly provide an update on MAG’s Interstate-10 and Interstate-17 Corridor Master Plan (“The Spine Study”) project.
