IV. 2012-13 Parks and Recreation Compliance Survey: ADA Access – 45 minutes

Summary: In September 2010, the Department of Justice (DOJ), published new, national, ADA design standards that require all jurisdictions with parks and recreation facilities to comply. The regulations call for enforceable accessibility standards known as the "2010 ADA Standards for Accessible Design." By issuing this ruling, the DOJ required each jurisdiction with parks and recreation facilities to conduct an audit and develop an action plan for compliance with the new rule, which took effect on March 15, 2012. The purpose of this item is to provide the City's consultant, Recreation Accessibility Consultants, LLC, with the opportunity to review with both the Parks and Recreation Advisory Commission and the Commission on Persons with Disabilities on its preliminary findings as required by the federal government. Additionally, the consultant will discuss the Department's prioritization and transition plan.

Recommendation: For information and discussion.
