- V. City of Glendale Transportation Master Plan – 30 minutes**

Summary: The Transportation Department recently initiated the process of updating the Glendale Transportation Master Plan. This update will define how the City's transportation system will improve and change over the next 25 years; how investments will be prioritized; and how decisions will be made. The Transportation Department will consider all modes of transportation—vehicles, bicycles, pedestrians, transit, and aviation.

Patrick Sage, City of Glendale Transportation Planner, will update on the process, including the various milestones and what to expect when the plan is completed.
