GLENDALÉ, Ariz. – The city of Glendale in partnership with the Arizona Foreclosure Prevention Task Force (Task Force) will host a free community event offering numerous resources to homeowners possibly facing foreclosure. Residents are invited on Wednesday, Feb. 29 from 3 to 8 p.m. to the Glendale Adult Center at 5970 W. Brown St. to meet with representatives from the Task Force, housing counseling organizations, lenders and city departments such as Neighborhood Services and Code Compliance to answer questions and provide advice.

The Arizona Foreclosure Prevention Task Force event will provide one-on-one counseling with certified, bilingual counselors and/or lender representatives and participate in workshops covering topics such as loan modifications, short sales, credit repair, scam awareness and more. All homeowners Valley-wide who are experiencing financial hardship, are behind on home payments and unsure about what to do, can find the assistance they are needing at this one-stop event.

- 2009 and 2010 tax returns
- Recent utility bill
- Last two bank statements
- Household expense budget
- Property insurance and mortgage statements
- Letter explaining hardship
