Spring 2025 Glendale University Program

I invite all Glendale residents and business owners to attend the Spring 2025 Glendale University (GU101) program. GU101 applications are now open. GU101 is a ten-week program sponsored by Arizona State University that is open to anyone who resides or owns a business in Glendale. During the ten-week course, participants learn more about the city and get an inside look at each department's operations, as well as meet the staff who make it all happen. Each week's class will be held in a different facility in the city and usually includes a tour of that facility.

The Spring 2025 GU101 classes will be held from 6 to 9 p.m. on Wednesdays beginning March 5, 2025, through May 7, 2025. The program is free and limited in size to encourage interaction among participants and the city staff who teach each class. To participate in GU101, you must be a Glendale resident age 18 or older or own a business in Glendale. Attendees who complete eight of the ten GU101 classes will be honored during a GU101 graduation ceremony held on the final night of class.
