GLENDALE CITY COUNCIL SELECTS LAUREN TOLMACHOFF AS VICE MAYOR

GLENDALE, AZ – The Glendale City Council has appointed Councilmember Lauren Tolmachoff to serve as Vice Mayor for the remainder of 2024 through 2025. As Vice Mayor, Tolmachoff will be responsible for performing the duties of the Mayor during the Mayor's absence.
