CITY OF GLENDALE TO HOST TRAVELING MUSEUM TO CELEBRATE NATION'S 250TH ANNIVERSARY

GLENDALE, AZ: The city of Glendale is honored and excited the America250 Commission has selected its Main Library to host the *Road to 250: Arizona Traveling Museum* presented by Banner Health. This is the only library in the West Valley chosen for this dynamic mobile piece of history.

What: The mobile exhibition housed in a custom-retrofitted trailer made possible by MRA Mobile Experiential features interactive exhibits that bring American history and Arizona's story to life as ways to celebrate the United States' upcoming 250th anniversary. The public will be able to explore the people, cultures and communities that shaped Arizona and see the state's replica Liberty Bell. Anyone may enjoy viewing Arizona's unusual story through immersive panels, along with a short looping video experience and interactive activations for all ages. Glendale also will provide music, lawn games, crafts activities and a scavenger hunt at its Main Library.

When: 10 a.m. to 6 p.m. on Friday, Feb. 20

Where: Glendale Main Library at 5959 W. Brown St. The mobile exhibition will tour all 15 counties in Arizona, stopping at libraries, city halls, museums, recreation centers and other cities, towns and rural communities' hubs.

Why: To generate enthusiasm and civic pride as our nation marks its 250th anniversary, with the mobile exhibition's kick-off in Prescott on Feb. 14, Statehood Day for Arizona.

Who: The city of Glendale, in partnership with Banner Health and America250 Commission, which is a non-partisan effort to commemorate the United States' 250th anniversary by honoring Arizona's role in American history.
