Jamie Aldama Elected Glendale Vice Mayor *Aldama Represents Glendale's Ocotillo District*

GLENDALE, Ariz. – The Glendale City Council has selected Councilmember Jamie Aldama to serve as Glendale's Vice Mayor for the year 2022. Councilmember Aldama was elected to the council and sworn in as the city's Ocotillo District Councilmember in December 2014.

As Vice Mayor, Mr. Aldama will be responsible for performing the duties of Glendale's Mayor during the Mayor's absence. He will serve in this position for one year.

Councilmember Aldama has deep roots in the community he serves. He is a lifelong, 4th Generation resident of Glendale, growing up and living in the Ocotillo District for most of his life. He and his wife Monica have been married for over 30 years, have three grown children and five grandchildren.
