

Amendment No. 2 to the 2020-2021 Annual Action Plan



The City was awarded funding of \$2,997,188 from the Emergency Solutions Grant Program (ESG-CV2) through the CARES Act and passed through the US Department of Housing and Urban Development (HUD). From this allocation \$2,497,188 was allocated to the Master Services Agreement for Homelessness Services through eligible ESG activities that include rapid rehousing, eviction prevention, essential services, street outreach, shelter operations and services. The allocation to the Master Services Agreement for Homelessness Services was reduced by \$32,823.14 by HUD, due to not meeting the expenditure deadline established for this award. This resulted in a reduced total allocation of \$2,464,364.90.
