## Summer 2026 Recreation Swim Schedule

**May 23 – July 26, 2026**

Tuesday through Saturday

**1:00 PM – 5:00 PM**

Both facilities are closed on Sundays and Mondays for maintenance.

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## What is Recreation Swim?

Recreation Swim, Open Swim, and Waterpark are all terms used to describe the times when the aquatic centers are open for public swimming and water play.

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## How much does admission cost?

Age Group	Glendale Resident	Non-Resident
Children 2 & Under	Free	Free
Youth (3–17)	\$2.50	\$3.50
Adults (18–54)	\$5.00	\$6.00
Seniors (55+)	\$3.00	\$5.00

Admission to be paid before entering the facility.

## What is included with admission?

Admission includes access to locker rooms, showers, restrooms, and all available aquatic features.

### Foothills Recreation & Aquatics Center

- Two large water slides
- Kiddie slide
- Zero-depth entry leisure pool
- Spray features
- Water playground
- Lazy river
- Diving well with two diving boards
- Lap lanes
- Snack bar

### Rose Lane Aquatics Center

- Zero-depth entry leisure pool
  - Spray features
  - Splash pad
  - Large water slide
  - Kiddie slide
  - Diving well with diving board
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## Can I bring food or drinks into the facility?

Outside food and beverages are not permitted.

Guests may bring:

- Factory-sealed water bottles
- Empty reusable water bottles that can be filled at drinking fountains

At Foothills Recreation & Aquatics Center, food and beverages are available for purchase at the snack bar and must be consumed in designated eating areas.

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## What swimwear is allowed?

Proper swimwear designed specifically for swimming is required.

Clothing not intended for swimming is not permitted in the pools.

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## Are swim diapers required?

Yes. Children ages 3 and younger must wear:

- A swim diaper, or
- Tight-fitting rubber or plastic pants

Patrons who are incontinent must wear appropriate protective garments to help maintain water quality.

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## Are lockers available?

Yes. Lockers are available for public use.

Please note:

- Locks are not provided.
  - Guests may bring their own lock or purchase one onsite.
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## How long can I stay?

There is no time limit during Recreation Swim hours. Guests may enjoy the facility until closing time.

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## Can I drop off my child?

Children under age 11 must be accompanied and actively supervised by a parent or guardian who is at least 18 years old.

Youth ages 11 and older may attend Recreation Swim without an adult present.

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## Can I bring floaties or inflatables?

Personal inflatables such as rafts, inner tubes, water wings, and similar items are not permitted.

Foothills Recreation & Aquatics Center provides tubes for use in the lazy river.

For safety, Coast Guard-approved life jackets are allowed and are also available free of charge at both facilities.

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## Are pets allowed?

Pets and emotional support animals are not allowed on the pool deck or in the water.

Service animals trained to assist individuals with disabilities are welcome; however, they may not enter the water.

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## What other aquatic programs are available?

### Foothills Recreation & Aquatics Center

Open year-round and offers:

- Lap swimming
- Water aerobics
- Swim lessons
- Private swim teams
- American Red Cross Lifeguard Certification courses
- Water Safety Instructor Certification courses

### Rose Lane Aquatics Center

Open seasonally during the summer months.

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## Are there other ways to cool off this summer?

Yes! In addition to our pools, Glendale offers several splash pads throughout the city.
