

# Glendale Rain Garden

Promotes Healthier Plants • Reduces Landscape Watering • Prevents Stormwater Pollution



**Before:** Raised mounds in the landscape directed rainwater away from the plants



**During:** More than 30 volunteers help create shallow basins to capture the rain (April 2014)



**After:** The rain garden in action capturing water and assuring that the desert plants will thrive

## Make Your Plants Happy, Build a Rain Garden!

**Spread and soak** - Shallow basins capture rain from roofs, driveways, and sidewalks

**Plant in and around basins** - All plants, particularly trees, will benefit from rainwater

**Remember** - One inch of rainfall from a 1,000 sq. ft. roof provides 600 gallons of water
