PROJECT UPDATE

During the next two weeks, the crews will continue:

- installing electrical conduit and foundations for the new parking lot lights
- placing concrete curb, sidewalks and driveway entrances
- installing the landscape irrigation system and water meter
- placing aggregate base course (ABC) material in preparation for paving the parking lot site in July

Please note crews will work from 4 a.m. to 5 p.m. on Saturday, July 2 and July 9 in order to complete the project by early August 2016.

ABOUT THE PROJECT


The city of Glendale is constructing a new parking lot on the southwest corner of 91st and Maryland avenues (the former Pendergast farm property).

The new lot will add 2,700 parking spaces to accommodate the number of visitors and employees to the Westgate Center. Additional improvements planned for the new parking lot site include the installation of storm water basins, curb, sidewalk, lighting and a screen wall.

TRAFFIC RESTRICTIONS

The majority of the work takes place off the roadway on the parking lot site. However, there may be traffic lane restrictions during the construction effort. Access will be maintained at all times for residents, businesses and emergency vehicles. Please allow extra time when

traveling through the construction zone as there may be traffic delays
