## September “Unexplained” Offerings at the Glendale Main Library

**GLENDALE, Ariz.** – Are you a person who sees everything in black and white? Sometimes there is a gray area that simply remains mysterious. “The Unexplained” series is an effort to bring clarity to some little known topics. The free programs run on Thursdays at 7 p.m. in the auditorium of Glendale Main Library, 5959 W. Brown St.

- On Sept. 7, nationally-known consultant, speaker and teacher Margaret Selby will present “Feng Shui.” She will discuss the Chinese art of placement and how it influences our everyday lives. According to Selby, the 4,000-year-old art has continued to be a main-stay practice in Asian countries, where people would never build a home or start up a new business without consulting a Feng Shui master. A few Feng Shui tips:
  - If you are starting a homebased business, place your office in the front of the house where the most active energy is located.
  - Bed placement should never be under a window; it creates poor memory, disorientation and restless sleep.
  - To increase career opportunities, clear away any weeds around the front entry and trim foliage blocking the entry way.
- “Personality, Birth Order and the Enneagram” is the topic of Laurie Schnebly Campbell’s presentation on Sept. 14. A counselor, Campbell can help one understand how and why siblings act the way they do. Were you the first born? The middle child? The baby of the family? Learn the characteristics of each ordinal position and

the nine personality types of the enneagram. Understand yourself and others better.

- Learn about guardian angels on Sept. 21 with Sunny Dawn Johnston. An intuitive counselor and medium, Johnson will present “Communication with Your Angels.” Do you know how to connect with your angels and to understand the guidance that they will provide? This class focuses on connecting with your angels through manifestation, intention, judgment, discernment and releasing fears. Participants will do exercises that teach one how to understand the guidance received.
