## **Glendale Police Department Spring Safety Fair**

**GLENDALE, Ariz.** – The Glendale Police Department’s Gateway

Division Community Action Team has scheduled a community crime forum to be held in the parking lot of Cabela’s at 9380 W Glendale, on Saturday, April 3, 2010 from 10 am to 2 pm.

Cabela’s will assist the Glendale Police Department in hosting the safety fair which will include the Glendale Fire department and the American Red Cross. The American Red Cross will be holding a blood drive and the Fire Department will have Fire Engines on display and be accompanied by Topaz, one of their Crisis dogs.

Glendale Police Community Action team officers and crime prevention specialists will be on hand with McGruff the crime dog to offer crime prevention materials, including auto theft prevention, gun safety, boating and water safety, and personal and home safety. They will also have information on the Take 25 campaign which is a program of the National Center for missing and exploited children. This program aims to heighten awareness of children’s personal safety issues. Focusing on prevention, the campaign encourages parents, guardians and other adult role models to spend 25 minutes talking to children about ways to be safer.
