

GLENDALE LAYS OUT OFFICIAL PLANS FOR AAA CORPORATE OFFICE

An agreement that represents the largest employer announcement in the West Valley in the history of the Greater Phoenix Economic Council.

- WHO:** Following a formal action by the Glendale City Council on Thursday, Governor Janet Napolitano, Mayor Elaine Scruggs and the Glendale City Council, representatives from Greater Phoenix Economic Council (GPEC) and representatives from the American Automobile Association (AAA) will be on-hand to formally announce the location of a regional corporate office for AAA of Arizona and the California State Automobile Association.
- WHAT:** The agreement will create up to 1400 jobs over the next three years, making it one of the city's top 5 largest employers. More than half will be considered "high-wage" positions, paying \$75,000 or more. The announcement will provide details of the agreement and outline largest West Valley locate in the history of GPEC.
- WHY:** This announcement fits with the city's overall strategy to bring quality, high paying jobs to Glendale. It is estimated that over 10 years Glendale will see direct revenues of \$12 million and the regional direct benefit is estimated at \$1.8 billion.
- WHERE:** Glendale City Hall, City Council Chambers, located at 5850 W. Glendale Ave.
- WHEN:** Thursday, January 26 at 3:30 p.m.
