## GLENDALE'S AQUATICS CENTERS OPEN FOR SUMMER JUNE 1

**Glendale, Ariz.** — Beginning June 1, the place to cool off this summer will be at one of Glendale's two aquatics centers as they open for the summer season. These mini-water parks have many of the great amenities of the big water parks without the cost or crowds.

Both aquatics centers feature recreation swimming, swim and diving lessons, adult water aerobics classes and private swim lessons, along with special areas for party rentals.

The Foothills Recreation & Aquatics Center, located at 5600 W. Union Hills Dr., features two slides, a diving pool, lap swimming, play structures, shaded areas, a concession stand and a lazy river. The Rose Lane Aquatics Center, located at 5003 W. Marlette Ave., features a slide, diving pool, lap swimming, play structures, shaded areas and a concession stand.

Recreation swim is available June 1 through Aug. 3. The days and times are as follows:

Admission to the aquatics centers is free for ages 2 and under, \$2.50 for ages 3-17 (\$3.50 for non-residents), \$5 for ages 18-54 (\$6 for non-residents) and \$3 for ages 55 and older (\$5 for non-residents).
