OFFICIALS RECOMMEND ALTERNATE ROUTES FOR SOLD OUT WHITE SOX-CUBS SATURDAY AT CAMELBACK RANCH-GLENDALE

Glendale, Arizona — Chicago's storied baseball rivalry is expected to bring a record Cactus League crowd to Camelback Ranch-Glendale, the first-year facility shared by the Chicago White Sox and Los Angeles Dodgers, when the defending American League Central Division champion White Sox welcome their hometown crosstown rivals, the defending National League Central Division champion Cubs, at 1:05 p.m. MST.

Saturday's sellout crowd is expected to establish a Cactus League single-game attendance record for the second time in six days at Camelback Ranch-Glendale. Last Tuesday, 13,046 fans attended the Cubs-Dodgers game that broke the previous mark of 13,010 set February 28, 2009 when the White Sox faced the Cubs in Mesa.

Alternate Routes — Camelback Ranch-Glendale officials encourage fans driving to Saturday's game to consider alternate routes to the stadium.

- From the east: I-10 west of Loop 101, Dysart Road or Litchfield Road exits, Dysart Road or Litchfield Road north, Camelback Road east.
- From the north: Loop 101 south, Glendale Avenue exit, Olive Avenue, Northern Avenue or Glendale Avenue west, El Mirage Road south, Camelback Road east.
