COUNCILMEMBER PHIL LIEBERMAN HOLDING TWO CACTUS DISTRICT MEETINGS THIS FALL

GLENDALE, Ariz. – Councilmember Phil Lieberman is hosting community meetings in October and November to update residents living in the Cactus District on citywide and district projects.

The first meeting is at 6:30 p.m., Thursday, October 23 at Horizon Elementary School, 8520 N. 47th Ave. A second meeting is scheduled for 6:30 p.m., Thursday, November 20 at Carol G. Peck Elementary School, 5810 N. 49th Ave.

Lieberman and representatives from city departments will cover such topics as residential housing foreclosures; vacant and abandoned properties; neighborhood grants; the Northern Parkway project; and Glendale University, a free educational program open to residents who want to learn more about their city government. Police Chief Steven Conrad will also give an update on how the city's public safety tax increase has assisted in hiring new officers. City staff will also be available to answer questions.

The Cactus District is located in the southeastern part of Glendale with the boundaries of 43rd to 51st avenues, Camelback Road to Peoria Avenue; and 51st to 59th avenues, Camelback to Bethany Home roads.
