## **COUNCILMEMBER MANNY MARTINEZ HOSTING FINAL CHOLLA DISTRICT MEETING OCT. 22**

GLENDALE, Ariz. - Councilmember Manny Martinez will be hosting his Fall Cholla District meeting from 6:30 p.m. to 8:30 p.m. on Wednesday, Oct. 22 at Foothills Recreation and Aquatics Center, 5600 West Union Hills Drive. The meeting will be held in the Center's Bobcat Room.

Martinez is encouraging residents living in the Cholla District to stop by his meeting to hear updates on neighborhood and city-wide issues, and discuss their ideas and suggestions for Glendale.

Special guests include Tom Duensing, Glendale's new Finance and Tech Director, who will talk about the Finance Department and the city's budget, and Jack Friedline, Glendale's new Public Works Director, who will discuss the areas he oversees, including Sanitation and Transportation.

The Cholla District is located in the northern part of Glendale and is bounded roughly from 51<sup>st</sup> to 83<sup>rd</sup> avenues, Union Hills Drive to Pinnacle Peak Road.

This will be the final district meeting for Martinez as he retires from the City of Glendale in December. Martinez was appointed to represent the Cholla District in October 1996, elected in March 1998 and re-elected in 2002, 2006 and 2010. Prior to joining the Council, Councilmember Martinez served a two-year term on the Glendale Commission on Neighborhoods and participated on the Glendale Magnetic Mile Committee.
