## **MONDAY NIGHT FOOTBALL DUI TASK FORCE**

**GLENDALE, Ariz.** – City of Glendale Police, along with the Governor’s Office of Highway Safety is hosting a DUI task force during Monday Night Football at University of Phoenix Stadium from 2 p.m. to midnight.

Several valley agencies will be participating in the task force with a total of about 30 to 40 officers involved in DUI enforcement that evening.

The command post for Monday Night Football operation will be located in the Cabela’s parking lot. A DUI van will be set up to conduct on-site mobile testing. Officers who apprehend suspected impaired drivers will bring them to this location for processing and booking.

Glendale Police encourage fans to have fun, but remind them to enjoy the game responsibly: If you drink, don’t drive. If you drink, designate a driver.

The media is welcome to the task force kick-off briefing at 2.p.m. and will be accommodated at the command post.
