## **GLENDALE TEAM TO PARTICIPATE IN WALK TO END DOMESTIC VIOLENCE**

**GLENDALE, Ariz.** – A group of individuals will make up Team Glendale and participate in the fourth annual Walk to End Domestic Violence on April 22. The event, which benefits domestic violence shelters, is a 5K run and fitness walk. It will begin at Wesley Bolin Plaza in downtown Phoenix, 17th Avenue and Adams near the State Capital.

More than 5,000 participants are expected and this year's fundraising goal is set for \$375,000. Last year, more than \$280,000 was raised for shelters throughout Maricopa County. The event is presented by The Arizona Foundation for Women,
