LAST DAY TO REQUEST EARLY BALLOT IS AUG. 17; ESPECIALLY IMPORTANT FOR THOSE REGISTERED AS “INDEPENDENT” OR “OTHER.”

Glendale, Ariz. — Voters registered as “Independent” or “Other” will need to state which primary election ballot they want to receive because they are not registered as a Republican, Democrat, Libertarian, Green or the Americans Elect political parties, and the last day to request their early ballot is Friday, Aug. 17.

Voters who are not affiliated with any political party and who are on the Permanent Early Voting List will not automatically receive a ballot for the Primary Election. They must request the political party ballot they wish to receive – Republican, Democrat, Libertarian, Green or the Americans Elect or the Glendale Elections Only ballot. Those not affiliated with a political party who do not advise the Maricopa County Recorder’s Office which ballot they want will need to cast their ballot in person at their designated polling place.

Glendale’s election includes voting for the Office of Mayor, as well as councilmember seats in the Sahuaro, Cactus and Yucca districts.
