GLENDALE HOSTS COOL EVENING OF SWIMMING, GAMES AND FUN

Glendale, Ariz. — While the Arizona summer heats up, families can cool down during a special evening to enjoy the waters of Glendale’s mini-waterpark at the Foothills Recreation & Aquatics Center.

Attendees can participate in a variety of games, enjoy the two giant water slides, float down the lazy river, splash in the aquatic playground, dive into the pool and play in the zero-depth entry leisure pool during the annual Family Swim Night, Saturday, July 14 from 5:30 to 8 p.m. Everyone will also receive a hot dog and lemonade.

The admission is \$4 per person for Glendale residents and \$6 for non-residents. Ages two and under are free. Arrive early since capacity is limited to the first 350 people.

Participants should note that coolers, chairs, glass containers, food and drink (other than water), toys, floaties, water noodles and floatation devices are not allowed in the pool area. Life jackets must be approved by the aquatics staff.

The Foothills Recreation & Aquatics Center is a full-service, recreation center serving the Glendale community. The center provides educational, recreational, fitness and social activities through classes, special events and ongoing center activities.
