IMPORTANT TRAFFIC INFORMATION FOR UPCOMING CARDINALS GAMES

GLENDALE, Ariz.– With the Arizona Cardinals first home preseason game just around the corner, the city of Glendale wants to inform football fans of important parking and traffic information to ensure the best fan experience possible in the city’s vibrant sports and entertainment areas in and around University of Phoenix Stadium.

Season Ticket Holders

Be sure to review your Arizona Cardinals parking pass prior to arrival. Please follow parking and traffic instructions and pay special attention to color-coded parking lot designations and temporary traffic restrictions in and around Westgate Entertainment District. A map of your assigned parking lot is provided on your pass. Be sure to hang your parking pass from your rearview mirror before entering the area.

Important Changes in Parking This Season!

- The Yellow Pass parking lot has been relocated to the west side of 91st Ave. just south of Maryland Ave.

Southbound Loop 101 Yellow Pass Traffic– Access your parking lot via Northern Ave. East to 91st Ave. south.

Northbound Loop 101 Yellow Pass Traffic – Access your parking lot via Glendale Ave. East to 91st Ave. south.

- Parking at Kellis High School is no longer available. Shuttle service will continue to be provided to Brown Pass ticketholders.

Westgate Parking Lots

Westgate Entertainment District offers parking areas for fans in the six parking lots that surround the center. Parking is free during pre-season games and \$10 (cash-only) during regular season games. Parking map and information can be found at www.westgateaz.com/visitorinfo/parking.

- Westgate lots are open all day, with charge for parking starting at 9 a.m. for daytime home games and starting at 1 p.m. for evening home games.
- Fans should enter Westgate Entertainment District from the north off of Glendale Ave. via 95th Ave. or 93rd Ave.
- Tailgating is permitted in Westgate Parking Lot Y, located at the southeast corner of 93rd Ave. and Glendale Ave. Charcoal grilling and glass containers are NOT permitted.
- Large RVs or motorhomes may be charged an additional fee. For information about large vehicle and tour bus parking accommodation, call 623-385-7500.

Game Day Traffic Updates

The Glendale Traffic Management Center, in partnership with ADOT, will be monitoring game day traffic and providing real-time traffic management and updates on all game days via Twitter at www.twitter.com/GlendaleTraffic. Fans can also call **511** for the latest updated traffic information.

Glendale Police will also be onsite during peak traffic times to direct traffic and help ensure a safe and steady traffic flow. Multiple dynamic messaging signs will be in place to direct traffic and provide real-time traveler information.

Additional Information

- Fans should be alert to pedestrians in walkways and crosswalks and drive safely and obey all temporary traffic signage.
- Season ticketholder parking lots open four hours prior to kick-off. Westgate parking lots are open all day.
- Vehicles are not permitted to stage on city streets prior to lot openings.
- Fans, taxi and limo drivers can download parking maps at www.glendalesgotgame.com.
- Uber/Lyft cabs staging area is located on Bethany Home Rd. between 91st and 95th avenues.
- **Be sure to hang your parking pass from your rearview mirror prior to entering the area.**

The NFL has implemented safety procedures regarding the type of bags that fans are allowed to bring in to the stadium. Acceptable bags include a clear plastic bag (sized 12" x 6" x 12"); a one-gallon plastic freezer bag; or a clutch (with either a shoulder or wrist strap) no larger than 4.5" x 6.5".
