GLENDALE AVENUE ROAD IMPROVEMENT PROJECT BEGINS

GLENDALE, Ariz. – As part of the city’s pavement management program, Glendale Avenue from 51st to 66th avenues will be improved with new rubberized asphalt this summer. The process uses recycled tires and is expected to extend the life of the roadway, reducing maintenance costs and decreasing traffic noise.

Construction is scheduled to begin in late June and end by early September. Much of the construction work will take place at night and message boards will be in place to alert drivers to traffic restrictions. During construction, traffic on Glendale Avenue will be limited to one lane only from 55th Drive to 58th Avenue. However, detours will be in place and bus routes will be rerouted using detours. Pedestrians will have access to businesses throughout the project.

This street upgrades are funded through federal stimulus funds as part of the American Reinvestment & Recovery Act (ARRA), and this project is a partnership with the Arizona Department of Transportation.
