## 2010 Glendale Centennial Plein Air Painting Winners

The Glendale Arts Commission sponsored the event on Feb. 6 in conjunction with Glendale's Office of Special Events at the Chocolate Affaire. Twenty-six artists entered competition in which a subject or scene had to be painted outdoors, somewhere within the city of Glendale. The artists could use oils, acrylics, watercolors or pastels. The canvas or paper had to be stamped prior to painting and the work had to be done during the hours of 8 a.m. and 5:30 p.m. on the event day.
