CITY OF GLENDALE SPONSORS 3rd ANNUAL RESOURCE FAIR

Public Invited to Free Resource Assistance Fair and Health Screenings at Glendale Civic Center

Glendale, Ariz. — The City of Glendale Community Services Department has partnered with Maricopa Integrated Health System for the 3rd Annual Health and Resource Fair this Saturday, Nov. 22. The fair is free and open to the public and offers onsite resource assistance for Glendale residents.

Utility assistance for residents who qualify will be available through the City of Glendale. In addition, the Salvation Army Project Share, Southwest Gas LIRA Discount Plan, SRP Economy Price Plan Monthly Discounts, AHCCCS Enrollment, WIC, Affordable Care Act and others will be on hand to offer onsite enrollment and assistance.

“It is a one-stop shop for residents from the city’s low-income population to attend and get so much help in one location,” Rebecca Daniel, Glendale’s Community Action Program Manager said. “Last year we had about 1,000 participants. Every year this event grows with agencies and residents.”

People attending the fair can also take advantage of the free health screenings and other medical treatment checks available. The first 250 families to attend will receive a free turkey for the upcoming holiday. The fair will be held on Saturday, Nov. 22, from 9 a.m. to 2 p.m. at the Glendale Civic Center, 5750 W. Glenn Drive.
