**COUNCILMAN PHIL LIEBERMAN HOSTING
PROPOSITION 401 INFORMATIONAL MEETINGS**

GLENDALE, Ariz. – Cactus District Councilman Phil Lieberman will host two meetings in August to inform his constituents on the upcoming Special Election.

On Sept. 11, 2007, residents will vote on Proposition 401 - Public Safety Funding Enhancement, a dedicated public safety sales tax increase that, if approved, would provide additional personnel and equipment for the Glendale Police and Fire departments.

The proposed increase would be four-tenths of one percent (.4%) on all sales except on the sale of food for home consumption. This equates to an additional four cents on every \$10.

The first meeting will be held on Thursday, Aug. 16 at Melvin E. Sine School, 4932 W. Myrtle Ave., in the school cafeteria. The following week, Lieberman will host another meeting on Wednesday, Aug. 22 at Sunset Elementary School, 4626 W. Mountain View Rd. Both meetings begin at 6:30 p.m.

Representatives from the Police, Fire, Budget and Finance departments will be present to provide information and answer questions on Proposition 401.
