**MAYOR ELAINE SCRUGGS APPOINTED TO
REGIONAL ECONOMIC DEVELOPMENT GROUP**

GLENDALE, Ariz. – Mayor Elaine Scruggs has been appointed to serve on the Maricopa County Association of Governments (MAG) Economic Development Committee.

The purpose of the committee is to assist MAG in providing a greater focus on the region’s future economic growth.

The group, which is made up of 25 business and government leaders from throughout the Valley, will develop an action-oriented plan that advances infrastructure in the region, especially transportation infrastructure that will enhance economic development opportunities.
