COMMUNITY MEETING DECEMBER 9**

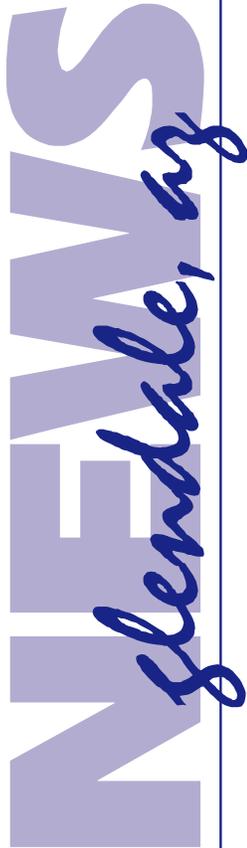
