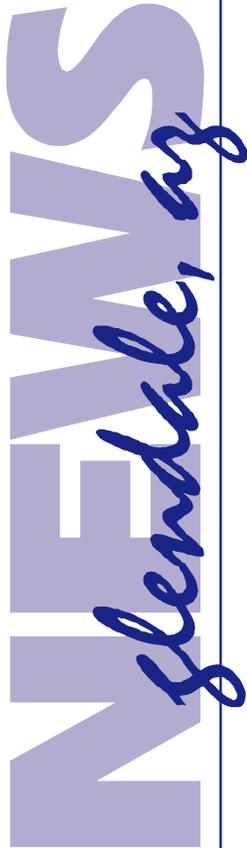
The main topics of the meeting will include:
