**PIONEER NEIGHBORHOOD DEDICATES STREETScape  
IMPROVEMENTS FUNDED BY NEIGHBORHOOD GRANT**

**GLENDALe, Ariz.** – Neighbors living in the Pioneer Neighborhood, near 63<sup>rd</sup> Avenue and Country Gables Drive, have new streetscape improvements as the result of a neighborhood grant. The Citizen’s Advisory Commission on Neighborhoods awarded the funds to the neighbors.

Councilmember Steven Frate, Sahuaro District, will present neighborhood leaders with a plaque to thank them for participating in the process to improve their neighborhood at a brief dedication ceremony beginning at 10:30 a.m., Thursday, April 24 at 6065 W. Maui Lane.

The Pioneer Neighborhood lists 225 households in the property that are more than 20 years old. The boundaries are between Greenway on the north to Country Gables on the south between 59<sup>th</sup> and 63<sup>rd</sup> avenues.

The Neighborhood Partnership Office administers a grant program that funds revitalization projects twice a year to assist neighborhoods more than 15 years old. Citizen participation and involvement are key components of the program.
