GLENDALE TO BEGIN WORK ON NEIGHBORHOOD IMPROVEMENT PROJECT FOR WEST PLAZA HOA

GLENDALE, Ariz. – Residents in the West Plaza One HOA will notice construction in their parking lot beginning next week.

The neighborhood received a Glendale Neighborhood Improvement grant of \$46,528 to repave a portion of their parking lot and driveway entrances. The HOA is located within the boundaries of 43rd to 44th avenues and Maryland to Ocotillo Road.

In addition to the funds provided by the city's grant, the neighborhood residents will be contributing an additional \$113,790 to the project.

The Neighborhood Partnership Office administers a grant program that funds revitalization projects twice a year to assist neighborhoods more than 15 years old. Citizen participation and involvement are key components of the program.
